





DIGIT-AL - Digital Transformation for Active Citizenship

DIGIT-AL delved into the societal and democratic implications of digitalization through a focus on democracy and human rights education. It produced practical resources, like a facilitator's handbook and policy recommendations, to enhance adult learning. Collaborating with European educational providers and NGOs, the initiative aimed to integrate digital competencies into active citizenship, moving beyond conventional technology use for a more involved societal role.

"For me, participation is about becoming active in creating our own projects, exploring civil initiatives and engaging in democracy-related learning. It's about moving beyond just using digital tools for learning to using them for citizen-led campaigning, self-organisation and enriching encounters at both national and international levels.
